- BLFC is an unsupervised environment intended for mature adults and is not responsible for the conduct of attendees. Parent agrees to indemnify and hold harmless both BLFC and the Grand Sierra Resort, and both companies' officers, directors, agents, volunteers, and employees with respect to all activities associated with, or any damages arising out of BLFC and from any cause of action of any nature arising from their child's participation in BLFC.
